

## State of Care 2015/16 interactive maps: guidance

The information in the State of Care maps reflect our ratings data as at 31 July 2016. More recent ratings data is available on [www.cqc.org.uk](http://www.cqc.org.uk).

The maps do not show locations that we have not yet visited and rated.

### Acute hospitals

We have displayed all locations that have been listed in our system as acute or acute specialist hospitals. A small number were previously rated but have undergone organisational change and are now shown as 'not rated'. Ratings of the predecessor organisation can however be accessed through our website.

If no overall rating was given for a location it is shown as 'not rated' but underlying ratings can be accessed in the pop-up box, or on our website.

Community health and mental health trusts are rated at trust rather than location level. The maps do not show trust level ratings.

### GP practices

We regulate every GP practice in England and show the locations of these practices. Some GP practices run branch locations – we do not show these on the maps.

### Using the maps



This button allows you to show or hide locations and/or geographical boundaries. There are a very large number of adult social care and GP practice locations and so you may need to zoom in to see data.



This button allows you to search within a fixed radius of a location. You can search for an address or click on the map. Closing the pop-up box removes the results.



This button allows you to search by different categories, for example you could find adult social care services in Rochdale that are rated good. Searches that have a large number of results may take longer to run.
