An overview of our work



The Care Quality Commission (CQC) commissioned research from *Opinion Matters* to explore people's experiences when choosing a care home for either themselves or for someone they love.

Together, we looked at how this compares to other important decisions that they have to make in their lives.


This survey sought views from 1,000 adults across the UK between 7 and 14 February 2018, who had been responsible for

making a decision about a care home in England in the last three years.




Which of the following life decisions did you find the most stressful to make?






Which of the following life decisions did you find the most stressful to make?






Overall adult social care ratings by region






What influenced you most when choosing a care home?




