



How we checked 33a Forest Road




We visited 33a Forest Road on May 2014.

People's privacy, dignity and being able to do things on their own was respected.


People were supported in keeping their independence and community involvement.




Care was planned and given in a way that made sure people were safe and looked after well. Staff knew peoples' care needs very well.




People were kept safe from abuse, or harm, at 33a Forest Road. Staff knew about safeguarding.

The owner had a good system to check that 33a Forest Road gave the best service and where needed made things better. The quality of service is regularly checked.
