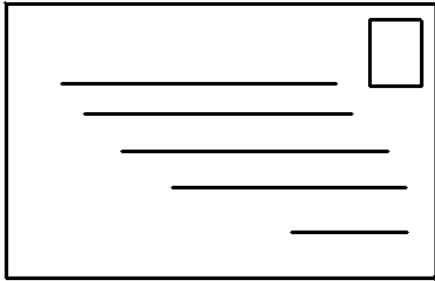

We gave this service a score of 'good'.



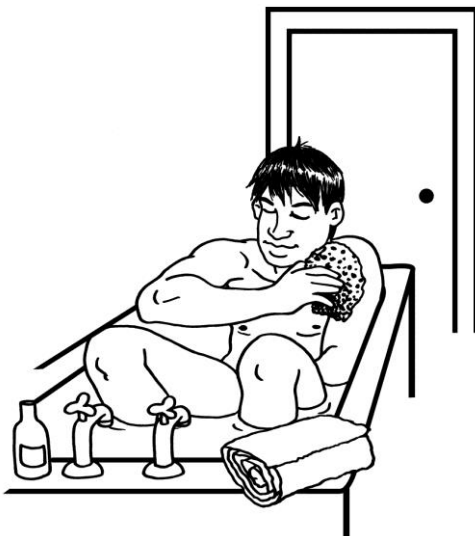
Staff received training and support to do their job.



Is the service caring?



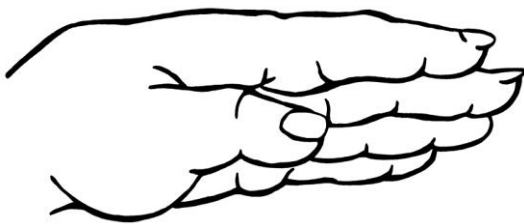
We gave this service a score of 'good'.
