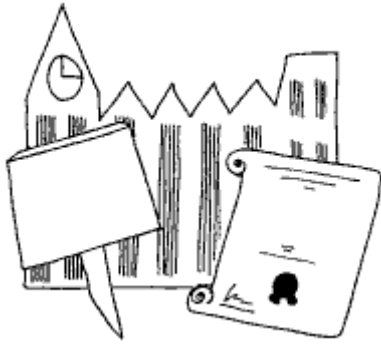

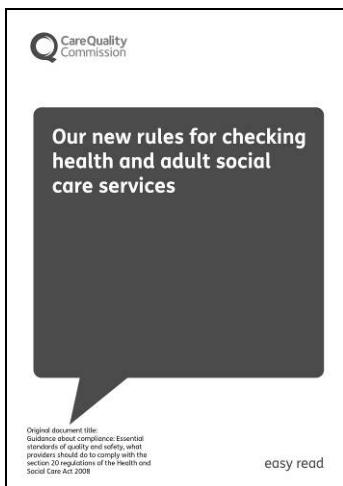

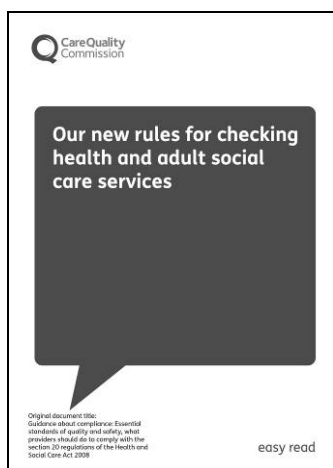
Introduction

We read some records.



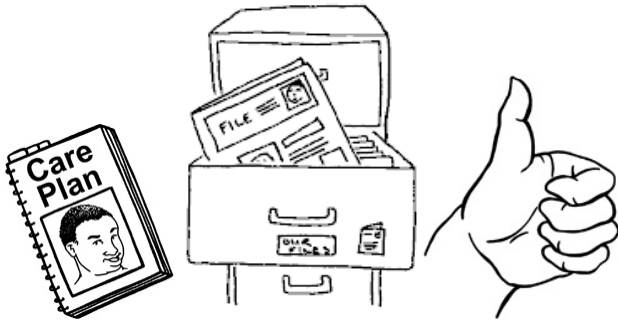
We thought about what we learnt.

People were involved in making decisions about their care with help from staff.



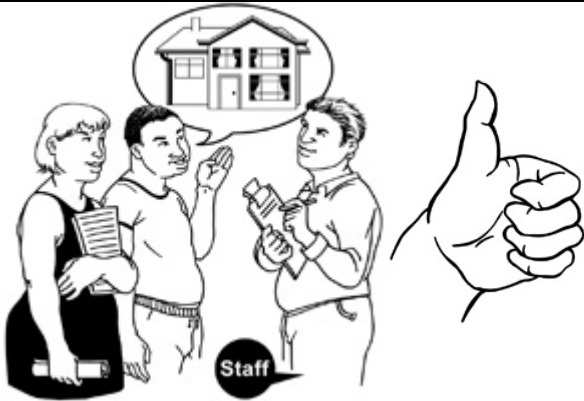
People were involved in how the service is run.

Staff	People who work at the service and help people who use it.
Essential standards	The most important rules about how a service should keep people safe and meet their needs.
