What this service was doing well to keep people safe from infections



People who were most likely to get very ill from an infection were supported in different ways.



For example, they had the same staff to support all their needs, like with their meals or just watching their favourite TV show with them.

People were kept safe from being infected by people visiting the service.



People were kept a safe distance from others when they needed to.



People arriving to use the service were supported to do this safely.



The service was using protective equipment, like gloves and face masks, in the right way.



People and staff were being tested to check if they had an illness, if they needed to.



The service was kept clean.

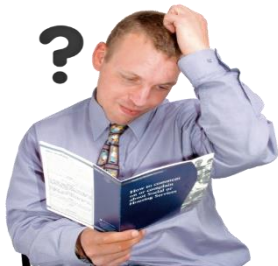


Staff were supported to help stop infections happening, with things like training.
