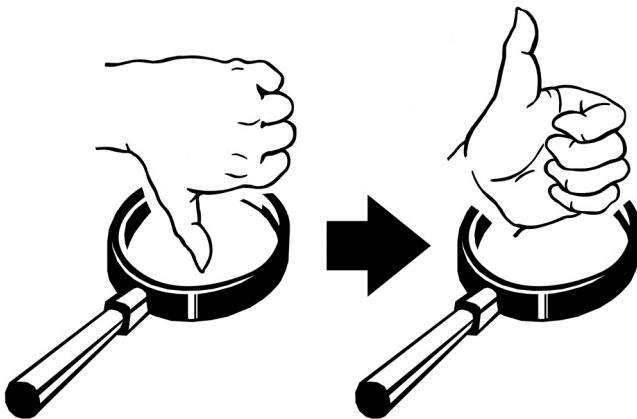

How we checked 40 Cody Road



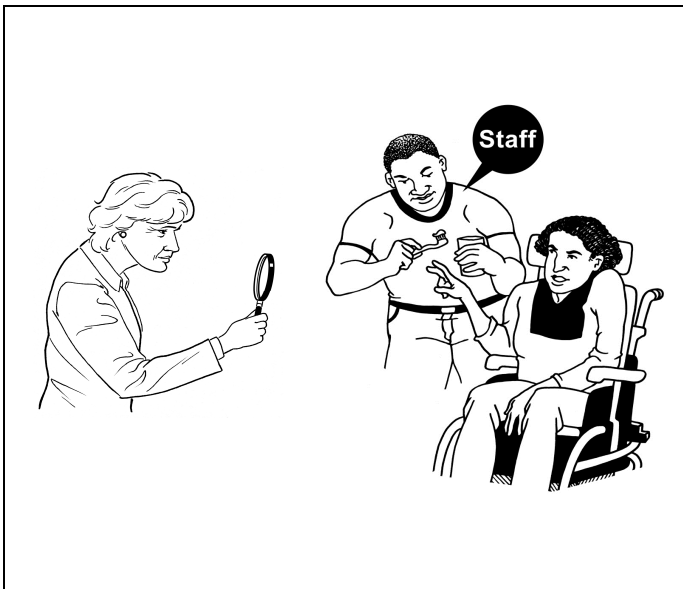
We visited 40 Cody Road on 8 November 2013.

Staff followed the law when people living at 40 Cody Road could not make choices themselves.

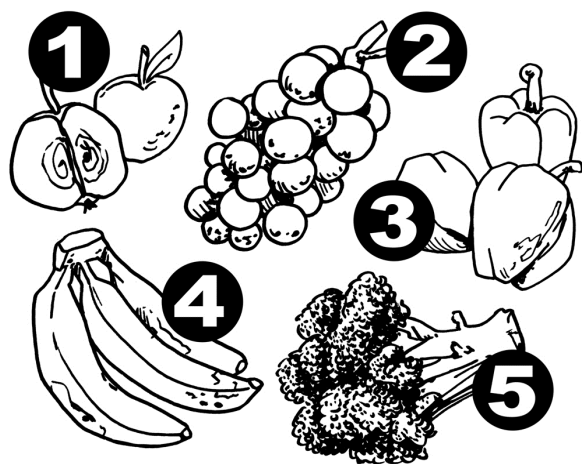




Care was planned and given in a way that made sure people were safe and well.



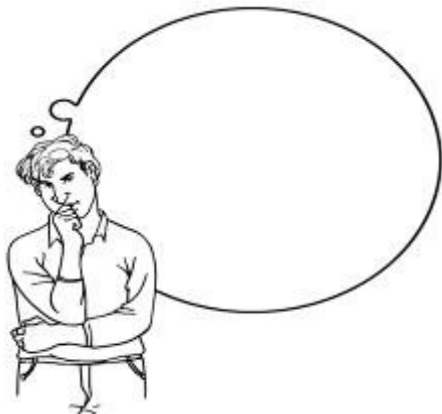
People's care plans and other records were up to date and person-centred.
